Twenty-Seventh Symposium Leadership for a Comprehensive Pastoral Juvenil

The Symposium is a one-week intensive experience during which the participants become familiar in theory and practice with the eight components of the Prophets of Hope model. This Model was designed by Instituto Fe y Vida in order to provide a pastoral-theological framework to guide the pastoral action of young leaders in their communitarian, evangelizing, and missionary efforts among their peers.

Goal —

To acquire a broadened vision—supported by processes, techniques, and resources—for the evangelization, faith formation, and pastoral care of Hispanic young people.

Spirituality, Discernment and Life Plan

Goal

Explore and deepen the knowledge about oneself, Christian spirituality, and the basics of discernment to undertake a coherent life plan.





Personal Knowledge -**BEING AND SEEING**

Objectives

- · Grow in the discovery and healing of one's personal journey.
- Deepen in the knowledge of the personal maturity and cultural identity processes.
- Integrate the personal history and personality traits as basic elements in the development of one's life plan.

Spirituality and Discernment - JUDGING

Objectives

- Understand what Christian spirituality is and explore the various schools of spirituality.
- Deepen the relationship with God through the pathways offered by Christian spirituality.
- Identify the sources that nourish spirituality and help grow in relationship with God.
- · Understand and value the elements for discernment in daily life and when making crucial decisions in life.

Life Plan - ACT

Objectives

- Get familiar with Jesus' life plan.
- · Promote a personal and communitarian encounter with Jesus Christ.
- Know the principles and criteria for developing a sound life plan.

Spiritual Growth -**CELEBRATE**

Objective: Carry out a spiritual retreat as part of the formation journey.

Topics


- Personal history and personality traits

What constitutes • **Instituto Fe y Vida's Leadership Training** System?

The Leadership Training System (LFS) consists of more than 30 programs organized into four levels, which can be offered locally in dioceses and parishes and in the National Leadership Program.

What characterizes each level?

- Foundational: Affirms the principles of faith and enables the development of ministry that is communitarian, evangelizing and missionary.
- Intermediate: Delves into different aspects of life and pastoral action, and provides methods and techniques for leadership in the Church and society.
- · Advanced: Delves into spirituality, theology and praxis for ecclesial leadership at the institutional level.
- Training of Trainers: Prepares people with the appropriate qualities to be local or national trainers and expand the reach of Fe y Vida's programs.





The Living Word of God Here and Now

That the Word of God may enlighten, motivate, and give direction to the lives of young people and their ministry among their peers

Objectives

- To get to know the word of god, pray with it, and to live it from the heart, individually and in community, in order to develop a spirituality centered on continual dialogue with the Word of God.
- To acquire the necessary tools to bring the Word of God to young people through the practice of Lectio Divina, adapted to pastoral juvenil and biblical missions led by young peo-
- To cherish the call to incarnate God's Word in the mission of the young Church today in order to lay solid foundations for the young Church of tomorrow.
- To understand the complementarity of Biblical Pastoral Mnistry and Biblical Animation of pastoral juvenil, in order to promote both in dioceses, parishes, and apostolic movements.

Resources for Animación of Biblical Pastoral Ministry

- La Biblia Católica para Jóvenes and La Biblia Católica para la Fe y la Vida: Exercises to get familiar with them and learning how to use creatively their didactic and pastoral contributions in communities, groups or movements.
- Serie Diálogos semanales con Jesús (Weekly Dialogues with Jesus series): How to use it for an incarnated spirituality in today's world and the Sunday liturgy.
- Youth Biblical Mission, "The Word becomes young with the young": What it consists of, its planning, and training of young missionaries.
- Planning and methodology to evangelize with the Word of God following the Prophets of Hope model, as a frame of reference for Biblical Animación at the diocesan, parish, or movement level.
- Biblical course: Systematic process for understanding, reflection, and interpretation of the Word of God.



Temas -

- Biblical spirituality: Living the Word of God as a source of life and conversion at a personal and pastoral levels
- Prayer, reflection, and biblical songs, as means to nourish spiritual life and build the Christian community
- Prayerful reading of the Word of God or Lectio Divina as a privileged means of prayer
- The Animación Bíblica of ministry to integrate the Word in daily pastoral life
- · Biblical pastoral care: A systematic and progressive process in the knowledge of Sacred Scripture


