TRAINING FOR PASTORAL ADVISORS FOR ADOLESCENTS

Module 2

This specialized training for those over 25 years of age trains to accompany, advise and guide Hispanic adolescents, parish groups and youth ministry leaders in their journey of faith. It offers theoretical foundations, practical methodologies, and applications to strengthen ministry with adolescents.

Objectives:

- Explore the essence of Christian spirituality—its meaning and characteristics—especially in the context of faith development during adolescence.
- Acquire basic knowledge in Catholic counseling and spiritual accompaniment to respond with empathy and compassion to the challenges faced by youth.
- Understand the principles and benefits of Christian coaching as a tool to build trust with adolescents and guide them on their journey of faith.
- Deepen the understanding of evangelization in the life of the Church and develop effective methods to communicate the Good News of Jesus Christ to young people.
- Design a well-structured training program by selecting the most appropriate pastoral model for the needs of the parish and the youth community.

TRAINING SEMINAR FOR FACILITATORS OF THE RESPETO AND HERENCIA PROGRAMS

It is an intensive training, designed for adult leaders who want to accompany and guide Hispanic youth and parents in their journey of faith. It provides the knowledge, skills, and resources needed to effectively implement: RESPETO, a post-confirmation leadership program for teens, and HERENCIA, a parent formation program, which strengthens their role as their children's first educators in faith and values.

- **RESPETO:** A post-Confirmation leadership program for adolescents.
- **HERENCIA:** A training program for parents that strengthens their

Through dynamic theoretical sessions, interactive workshops, and practical applications, participants will be equipped to form, advise, and empower both youth and parents, promoting their spiritual and personal growth within their communities. This seminar is ideal for young adults (25+ years) interested in serving as youth mentors or advisors; parents or adult leaders keen on supporting faith-based youth groups; couples or parents wishing to establish a Parent School in their community; and priests and religious involved in faith formation processes for youth and families.

Objectives:

- Empower parents as leaders in faith and family, reinforcing the idea that the home is the first Church where faith and values are nurtured.
- Provide parents with specialized training in modern parenting strategies based on psychological theories and Catholic values, enabling them to effectively guide their children and replicate these models in their parish communities.
- Develop dynamic activities and educational materials that facilitate family engagement in learning and behavior transformation, ensuring that the training aligns with their social and cultural realities.
- Foster a renewed commitment to the Gospel among leaders by emphasizing biblical principles, Catholic doctrine, and the Church's teachings on the pivotal role of parents in the moral and spiritual formation of their children.
- Address urgent moral and social issues affecting today's families, including high rates of divorce, adolescent depression and suicide, loss of values, substance abuse, gang violence, and the growing influence of ideologies that disrupt family dynamics.

UNDERSTANDING... TO HEAL – PASTORAL MENTAL HEALTH TRAINING

It is designed to empower pastoral leaders, priests, religious and lay ministers, providing them with the knowledge, skills and tools necessary to create safe spaces of reflection, support and healing within their communities.

Objectives:

- Provide participants with specialized training in mental health care and early intervention, enabling them to prevent and bolster the emotional well-being of families—especially adolescents and young people within the parish community.
- Deepen the understanding and practical application of techniques and strategies for managing anger, coping with depressive thoughts, and controlling anxiety, stress, and other psychological challenges faced by young people.
- Equip leaders with educational tools, resources, and activities that facilitate family engagement in mental health awareness and behavior change, thereby helping to develop community programs focused on mental health prevention for both youth and adults.
- Raise awareness among pastoral leaders about the extraordinary role of faith in emotional healing—addressing childhood wounds, restoring a positive and hopeful mindset, and empowering individuals for action. The seminar emphasizes the importance of an authentic relationship with God, promoting a deeper, more fruitful prayer life as a means to face modern challenges.
- Reflect from both a moral and scientific perspective on the critical issues affecting today’s families, including high rates of divorce, adolescent depression and suicide, loss of values and respect among youth, substance abuse, gang involvement, and the influence of modern cultural trends on identity and sexuality.

GENERAL INFORMATION

I. AGE AND LANGUAGE

The National Catholic Leadership Program is designed for persons 18 years of age and older. No one under 18 will be accepted.

The process, presentations, and materials are in Spanish, except for the programs marked "bilingual". Participants may express themselves in English or Spanish. Some communities use Spanish, others English, and still others do their work bilingually.
